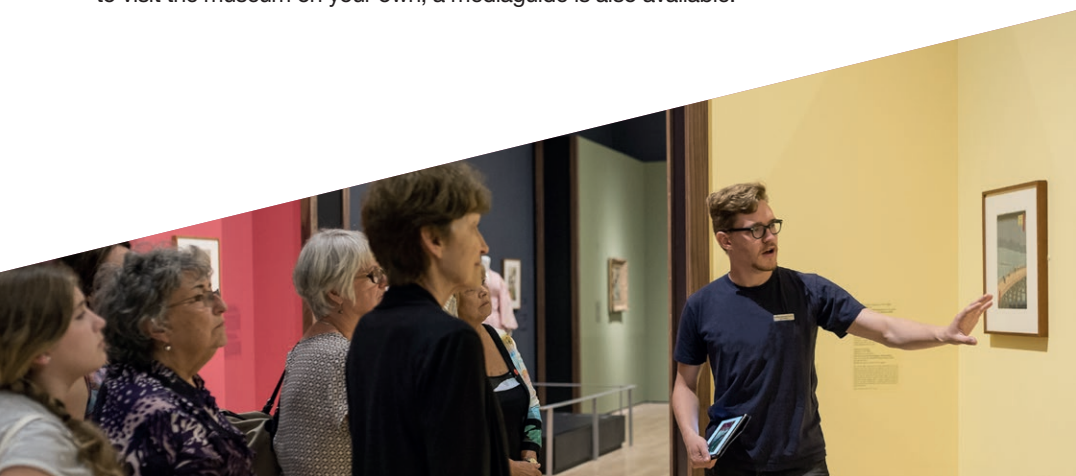
DISCOVER A WORK OF ART

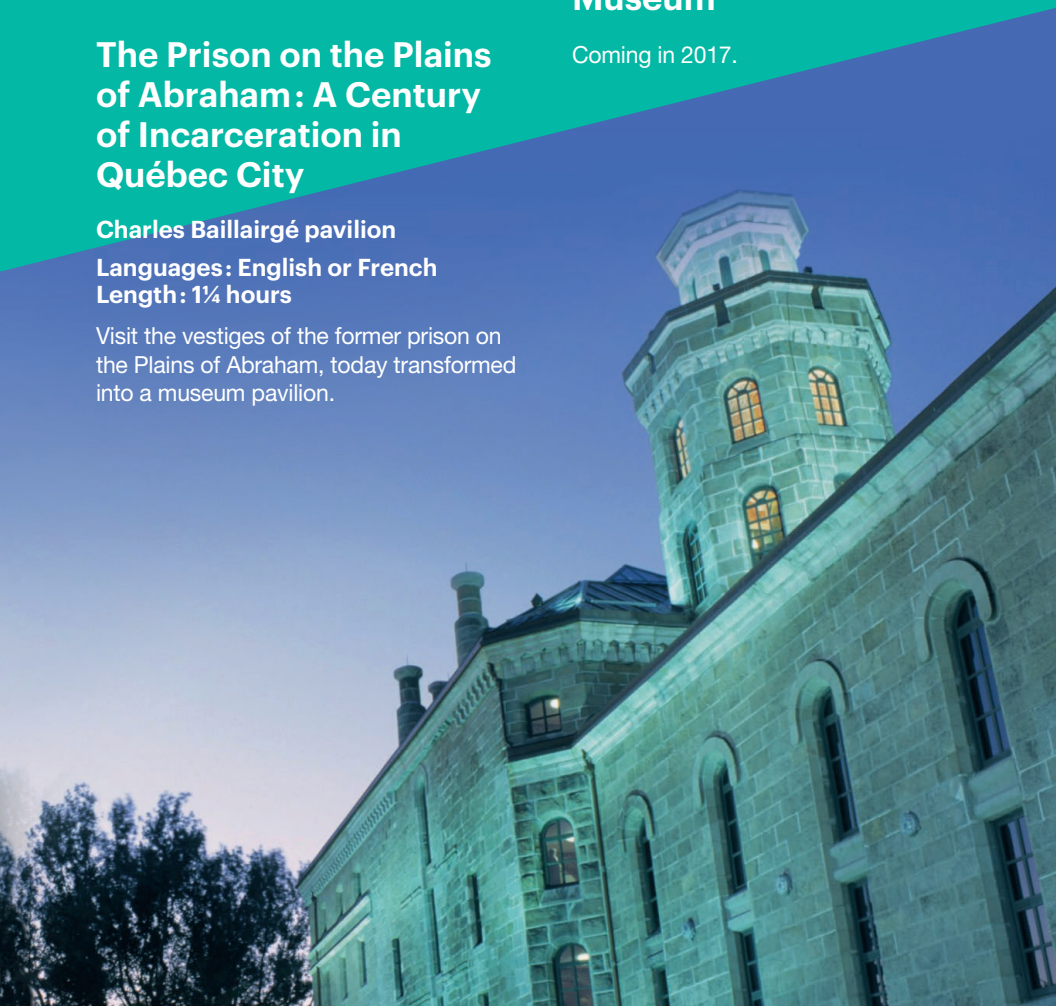
